**RESUMÉ**

She has forged a highly respected career over three decades by creating compelling sculptures in bronze that are imaginative and exude vitality in their subjects, which range from dynamic and historic figures to western sculpture and wildlife. These sculptures are the icons of heroes to our world and to us as individuals and seek to capture not only the historical background but the soul and essence of the figure. The sculptures go beyond the immediate interpretation into the psychological aspects of self-realization, worth, and growth by using a traditional presentation with a twist. Bobbie received her Fine Arts Degree from Brigham Young University and has gained influence for her work from Michaelangelo, Solon, and Gutzon Borglum, Rodin, Daniel Chester French, and Leonardo Bistolfi. Further, her own life's struggles with its hard-won insights, as well as her seven children, have been inspirational to many of her works. She has studied under many of the notable artists of today, including Angelo Frudakais and Albert Wein. Her works are internationally renowned and collected with over 200 public and private commissions and installations. Her works are installed in countries around the globe.*

Bobbie Carlyle has been a professional figurative bronze sculptor for over 25 years with experience spanning nearly 40 years. Her career started with a natural affinity for art, which she has continued to develop. Her greatest creative enjoyment comes from exploring the subject and coming up with the entity that fully symbolizes it. She has developed much sculpture for private and corporate clients, as well as creating fully integrated artistic site design. She earned a Fine Art degree from Brigham Young University and has studied under many of the notable artists of today including Angelo Frudakais and Albert Wein. She became significantly well known for her piece *Self Made Man*, which continues to strike a chord with people. By utilizing her Colorado network of world-class sculpture foundaries, she is fully capable of providing site-specific sculptures while personally maintaining quality control over the entire process, thus ensuring artwork that will last a lifetime. This network has been the backbone of her studio for some time. They work well as a team and together have completed all of the work in her portfolio.
