Career Summary

For over 30 years Dirk has been involved in the arts in almost equal parts as an exhibiting visual artist and as an arts teacher and community art facilitator. In 2016 he added storytelling and theatrical presentations to his artistic practice using the fine art of puppetry.

- VISUAL ART Dirk's visual art consists mainly of paintings and sculptures. Other mediums include digital art, animation, illustration, tile mosaics, murals, and recently augmented reality art. The themes of DIrk's artwork range widely but his leanings are towards nature, spirituality, and the use of traditional African iconography as well as other global indigenous visual references to inspire authentic relationships with self, community, and nature. His artwork has been exhibited in galleries, libraries, schools, restaurants, etc. While living in NY in the 1990's Dirk was the president of the Long Island Black Artist Assn. He enjoys public festivals where he can engage directly with the community while presenting his art. He has done an extensive amount of graphic design including web design for numerous clients.
- ART TEACHING/COMMUNITY ARTS Dirk has been teaching art since 1993 when he first started
 volunteering in his local elementary schools. This led to him working for several "teaching artist" agencies in
 NY and MD, slide lecturing at several universities in NY. Dirk has worked as a middle-high school art teacher
 in Baltimore. As a community arts facilitator Dirk frequently partners with some Baltimore based community
 organizations.
- PERFORMANCE In 2014 Dirk co-founded a two person puppetry performing team called The Drapetomaniacs with artist Pierre Bennu. In 2016 Dirk founded String Theory Theater, a traveling puppetry troupe consisting of Dirk and his daughters Koi and Azaria. STT creates and conducts puppet shows for adults and children and performs at venues throughout Maryland such as the Baltimore Center Stage, Creative Alliance, BMA, Black Cherry Puppet Theater. They have traveled beyond MD to perform at the Detroit Institute of Art, UCONN, and multiple locations in DC. STT have contracted with the Board of Education and the Enoch Pratt Free Library for public performances and have received several grants and awards. In 2021 Dirk wrote a screenplay for a theatrical film titled *Underground* that was performed by the Baltimore Rock Opera Society. In 2023 Dirk was awarded a grant by the Jim Henson Foundation to develop a production titled *Defrag*. In October 2023 Dirk made his curatorial debut as he curated, hosted, and performed in a puppet slam in the Locally Grown Festival at Baltimore Center Center
