

2021 ART 250 & ART 599A – Sculptural Forms

ART 240 - Tools, Crafts, & Techniques

2020

ART260 – Introduction to Printmaking students will be exploring several forms of printmaking including relief printmaking, one of the oldest methods of image reproduction, intaglio, pronto plate lithography, along with collagraphic and experimental techniques. We may even enter the realm of technology in printmaking. An emphasis will be placed on non-toxic printmaking techniques and the use of color, with experience in chine-collé, multi-block printing, monotype, and/or reductive approaches. Students will apply competencies in basic drawing and design to create several print editions exhibiting a high standard of craft and concept. Aesthetic development of imagery will be heavily discussed throughout the course. Additionally, students will be encouraged to incorporate mixed media techniques, potentially moving from the realm of 2D into 3D. Researching historical and contemporary printmakers will contribute to expanding the knowledge of the possibilities of expression through the relief print. The course will cover printmaking history and technical processes through lecture, demonstration and class readings. Students will develop a portfolio of prints that represent a manifestation of overall artistic quality and craftsmanship, demonstrating a visual art vocabulary that successfully utilizes the two-dimensional elements and principles of art and design. Additionally, mixed media techniques and the incorporation of three-dimensional design will be highly encouraged.

ARTT343 – ELEMENTS-SCREEN PR This is an introductory studio course designed to familiarize students with the basic principles and concepts of screen printing processes. Through technical demonstrations, students are initially introduced to the basics of drawing and stencil printing as well as rigorous printing and registration training. Then students progress to more advanced additive, reductive, color methods of screen making and printing. Emphasis is placed on properly editioning prints as well as working with variable editions, as students are introduced to experimental printmaking practices and mixed media. Critical written and verbal evaluation in addition to aesthetic understanding of artwork produced and their display play an equally important role in this course.

ARTT 448E, ADV SCREEN PR This advanced studio course is designed to offer students, previously familiar with screen printing techniques to further explore and develop their practice. The emphasis of the course, is for students to create a portfolio of prints that represent a manifestation of overall artistic quality and craftsmanship, demonstrating a visual art vocabulary that successfully utilizes the two-dimensional elements and principles of art and design. Additionally, mixed media techniques and the incorporation of three- dimensional design is highly encouraged as students are told to THINK OUTSIDE OF THE BOX (or rather off the page). Also, students will learn about professional practices for writing proposals and implementing them through utilizing time management and problem-solving skills. Additional training and

ARTT 341 – ELEMENTS-WCUT/RELF This is an introductory studio course that focuses on the investigation of the oldest method of image reproduction with an approach that encompasses traditional techniques of woodcut and wood engraving as well as linoleum. Experimentation is encouraged with collagraphic techniques in addition to touching on the realm of technology in printmaking. An emphasis will be placed on the use of color in this course, with experience in chine-collé, multi-block printing, monotype, and/or reductive approaches. Students apply competencies in basic drawing and design to create several print editions exhibiting a high standard of craft and concept. Aesthetic development of imagery will be heavily discussed throughout the course. Additionally, students are encouraged to incorporate mixed media techniques, potentially moving from the realm of 2D into 3D. The viewing of historical and contemporary relief prints will contribute to expanding the knowledge of the possibilities of expression through the relief print. The course will cover printmaking history and technical processes through lecture, demonstration and class readings.

ARTT 341H - Honors ELEMENTS-WCUT/RELF This course is for honors students seeking to gain experience at an introductory or advanced relief printmaking and mixed media level, based upon their previous experience. Emphasis will be placed upon the creation of a print portfolio representing a manifestation of overall artistic quality and craftsmanship, demonstrating a visual art vocabulary that successfully utilizes the two-dimensional elements and principles of art and design. If student does not have previous printmaking experience I incorporate them into my intro level relief printmaking class, otherwise they are encouraged to work in a similar manner as my advanced printmaking courses.

ARTT 448F, ADV WOODCUT & RELIEF This advanced studio course will build upon techniques learned in previous art courses with a heavy emphasis on utilizing traditional techniques of relief printmaking. However, students are not confined to relief printmaking techniques and are highly encouraged to integrate other mark making, mixed media, and installation techniques into their work, THINKING OUTSIDE OF THE BOX (or rather off the page). Additionally, the use of technology-based art practices will also be encouraged. The emphasis of the course, is for students to create a portfolio of prints that represent a manifestation of overall artistic quality and craftsmanship, demonstrating a visual art vocabulary that successfully utilizes the two-dimensional elements and principles of art and design. Students learn about professional practices for writing proposals and implementing them through utilizing time management and problem-solving skills. Additional training and demonstrations are provided as needed, along with individual and peer discussion of in-progress work culminating in a final project critique.
