Interests

An artist since my kindergarten years, when in high school, I attended a local Art Center studio run by a professional artist and already had international exhibits

in Warsaw, Dusseldorf and Amsterdam. While in art school, in a Graphic Design Dept.,

I was developing art language theories, later presented in a paper, while pursuing

a master degree in Art History at UMd in College Park. With a dramatic switch, I decided to study sciences and published an article on Arts and Sciences in Artists Equity Newsletter, Baltimore Chapter, of which I was an editor. I managed to get a medical degree in meantime. I also did several biomorphic paintings, reflecting my new interests. Recently I have concentrated on digital art and fractal, and repurposed art. With some diligence, I overcame its trite albeit spectacular aspects, and discovered (for myself) new forms of artistic expression. Even more recently – it's sculpture with Baltimore Sculptors (3 exhibits so far). My press release of Havre de Grace exhibit at Artists' Emporium was published at Aegis, a Sun Paper publication.

My art manifests a peculiar resonance between spirituality and various physical and

biological phenomena intuitively oscillating between the two. I am still looking for new media and planning new ventures. I also try to define the art trends and working on my book on Art and Science.
