Synopsis

Bazaar is a crime thriller with elements of the techno-thriller and conspiracy fiction genres. When the son of a Nigerian ambassador is found murdered along with his best friend in the U Street district of Washington, D.C, the homicide investigation reveals to the public an extensive assassination market on the darknet called the Bazaar. Its vast list of potential targets with cryptocurrency price tags next to their names not only gives rise to contract killers including plastic gun manufacturing teenager Aaron Williams and senior vigilante Merlin Erazo but also the private contractors who protect the hunted politicians and celebrities.

Karen and Yemi Uzunma are the two sibling owners of the security firm known as Raptor. They form the first-ever executive protection squad primarily focused on providing 24-hour protection for Bazaar-tied VIPs in the DC area that are looking to remain alive on their predicted death dates. While they put together an elite team with limited resources, Aaron carefully joins up with local drug dealer Rold Jenkins to pull off a lucrative hit job on the ambassador himself, Chiedu Attah.

As Raptor takes on new clients including Attah, they battle in the streets of the DC metro area with Williams, Jenkins, Erazo, and other combatants who see the rise of the Bazaar as their ticket to financial freedom.
